No.HCM.II/12/2013-Estt/300. - Subject to admissibility of leave to be certified by the Accountant General (A&E), Meghalaya, Shillong, Smti. Nausica M. Sangma, Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Garo Hills District, Tura is granted combined leave for a period of 12 (twelve) days with effect from 20th April, 2026 to 1st May, 2026, *suffixing* 2nd & 3rd May, 2026 being holidays as admissible under the Rules, are as under:

- (1) Commuted Leave on medical ground with effect from **20th April, 2026 to 30th April, 2026** = 11 days.
- (2) Earned Leave on medical ground *i.e.* on **1st May, 2026** = 1 day.
