The functions of the Council shall be to:

- Conduct conciliation in the matter of delayed payment to Micro and Small Enterprises. The Council may either conduct conciliation itself or seek assistance of any institution or centre providing alternate dispute resolution services by making a reference to such an institution or centre for conducting under provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- Take up dispute of delayed payment to Micro and Small Enterprises for arbitration or refer it to any institutions or centre providing alternate dispute resolution services for such arbitration where the conciliation is not successful or stand terminated.

- (c) Conduct all such functions as authorized under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 and the Meghalaya Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council Rules, 2019.

The Council shall have jurisdiction to conciliate or arbitrate in dispute between supplier located within the State of Meghalaya and buyer located anywhere in India.

II/430/Pt/Estt of 2013/1840. - In exercise of the power conferred under Rule 66 of 'The Meghalaya High Court (Live Streaming of Court Proceedings) Rules, 2022,' and in terms of the Full Court Resolution dated 20th May, 2026, the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court of Meghalaya is pleased to amend 'The Meghalaya High Court (Live Streaming of Court Proceedings) Rules, 2022' as follows:

1. In addition to point i to xi of Rule 6.2, the following will also be excluded from live streaming:
 - xii. child adoption matters;
 - xiii. child custody matters;
 - xiv. matters registered under or involving the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971;
 - xv. offences or proceedings under relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023;
 - xvi. in-camera proceedings under the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023;
 - xvii. any proceedings involving minors or other vulnerable persons where privacy considerations arise.
2. Rule 14. Reference to Words and Expressions:

Words and expressions used and not defined in these Rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them by the law for the time being in force, including the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023; Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023; Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023, Information Technology Act 2000, CPC, the CrPC, Indian Evidence Act, 1872, the General Clauses Act, 1897 and other applicable laws for the time being in force.
